## **Preparation**

### **1. Prepare a brief presentation of your paper**

Prior to the workshop, you should prepare a 5-minute pitch to all participants. We ask you to stay within the 5-minute time limit. You are not asked to prepare any additional presentation for your group. We want to focus on the feedback and discussion.

### **2. Read the papers in your group and prepare comments and constructive feedback**

Furthermore, you are expected to read all the papers in your group and prepare constructive feedback, comments, and suggestions to the papers you are first and secondary discussant for. Each session lasts one hour, and ideally most participants should have a chance to offer comments and suggestions.

Therefore, we ask that the discussants plan for roughly 10 – 15 minutes of feedback and dialogue with the authors. Please keep a constructive tone throughout the workshop. Each group also has a facilitator. We have contacted these separately.

### **3. Technical preparation**

Please make sure that your camera and microphone are in good order. We encourage you to have the camera turned on, and the microphone turned off when you are not speaking.
